The Robert D. Lemon Social Justice Award Nomination

Description of Award

Through The Robert D. Lemon Social Justice Award, the Center for Social Justice honors one student, one faculty member, and one staff member who demonstrate compassion, courage, and leadership. Nominees are individuals who work to eliminate discrimination, oppression, and injustice locally and globally. The three Robert D. Lemon Social Justice Awards are presented at the end of the spring semester.

Criteria and Application Instructions.

Nominees for The Robert D. Lemon Social Justice Award must be part of the University of Oklahoma community, and nominations are accepted from all departments. They must be strongly involved in a project/organization dedicated toward some issue of social justice. The nominee must demonstrate leadership by acting as an advocate and role model for their chosen causes within the university and the wider community.

Nominators must submit a completed application, consisting of this nomination form, a copy of the nominee's CV or resume, and a letter of nomination.

- o The letter of nomination should contain clear references to how the nominee has demonstrated leadership, courage and compassion in his/her work as a social justice advocate as well as indicate how long the nominee has been working as an advocate or role model for his/her chosen cause.

The completed application packet must be submitted to the Center for Social Justice (Robertson Hall, Room 103) by MARCH 31, 2017 AT 4PM. Applications can also be submitted in person or by email to center.for.social.justice@ou.edu.
